
Corporate Prayer of Confession:

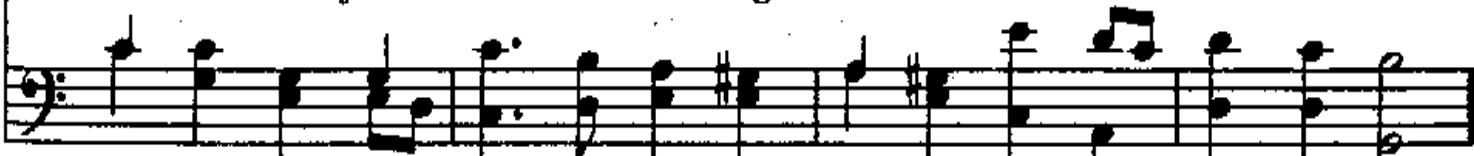
