From our violations of your just Law, forgive us through the perfect obedience of our Lord, and empower us to love mercy, do justice and walk humbly with You. Finally, we ask you to receive our praise and worship, for we speak in the blessed name of Jesus, and seek the visible manifestation of His Kingdom on earth, Amen.

**Arise and Receive the Assurance of Pardon & Forgiveness:**

"God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus." Ephesians 2:4-8

I am poured out like water, and all My bones are out of joint; My heart is like wax; It has melted within Me. My strength is dried up like a potsherd, And My tongue clings to My jaws;

**You have brought Me to the dust of death. For dogs have surrounded Me; The congregation of the wicked has enclosed Me. They pierced My hands and My feet; I can count all My bones. They look *and* stare at Me.**

They divide My garments among them, and for My clothing they cast lots. But You, O Jehovah, do not be far from Me; O My Strength, hasten to help Me! Deliver Me from the sword, My precious *life* from the power of the dog. Save Me from the lion's mouth and from the horns of the wild oxen!

**You have answered Me. I will declare Your name to My brethren; In the midst of the assembly I will praise You. You who fear Jehovah, praise Him! All you descendants of Jacob, glorify Him, and fear Him, all you offspring of Israel!**

For He has not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; Nor has He hidden His face from Him; But when He cried to Him, He heard.

**My praise *shall be* of You in the great assembly; I will pay My vows before those who fear Him. The poor shall eat and be satisfied; Those who seek Him will praise Jehovah. Let your heart live forever!**


